**Proudly Announces that Dawn Fisher is coming to our Chapter
In February 2024 to teach!**

Dawn Fisher will be teaching at the Indian River Chapter of the EGA on February 12 thru 14, 2024!

Dawn will teach a one-day class (Grandma's Button Box) followed by a two-day class (Alphabet of Stitches Redux). Both require some pre-work (I think primarily counted basting), so kits will arrive in January. Pre-work allows students to get easily accomplished tasks done before the class, providing more time for learning during the class.

The cost per class is based on 10 students per class. If more than 10 students enroll in a class, then you are likely to receive a refund once all costs have been calculated. *If we cannot make 10 students in a class, that class will be cancelled.*

The classes to be offered are

- Grandma's Button Box (GBB): \$165 EGA Members/\$186 Non-EGA-Members for the one-day class including lunch Monday Feb 12
- Alphabet of Stitches Redux (ASR): \$241 EGA Members/\$266 Non EGA Members for the two-day class including lunch both days. Tuesday Feb 13 & Wednesday Feb 14

Participants can take one or both classes.

Both these classes require some pre-work, so we are going to put this registration on the Quick Path meaning you need to respond NOW!

A deposit is due by the Monday Dec 18th for EACH class you sign up for. This is a commitment that you will be taking the class, IF THE CLASS DOES NOT GET 10 ENROLLEES, your deposit will be returned.

How much is the Deposit? If you are a member of EGA, your deposit will be \$75. If you NOT a member of EGA your deposit will be \$100.

The payment schedule (if you don't want to pay the whole fee up front) is as follows:

Feb 13, 2024: \$81 when you come to class

Here is a description of the classes.

Grandma's Button Box. \$165, including lunch (1 day class). Mon. Feb 12, 2024



DESCRIPTION: You will learn numerous stitches, including Lazy Daisy, Rhodes, Detached Buttonhole, Eyelet and others. The kit will include vintage buttons plus students are encouraged to bring their own buttons if they want to personalize their box. Three alphabets will be provided for personalization.

GROUND & THREADS: The fabric for the top is 28-count linen and the box is wrapped in 2-inch wide 18-count banding. Threads used are Sulky's 12 weight cotton petites.

NOTE: Students need to provide their own Whitman Sampler's box (or the piece can be framed). The 12 oz box is the one used for class which is approximately 9 inches by 5.75 inches.

STUDENTS PROVIDE: Usual stitching supplies, including scissors, extra magnification and lighting (optional, but must be battery operated, i.e., no extension cords). A stitching frame or scroll rods are strongly recommended for this sampler.

PRE-WORK REQUIRED. KIT WILL BE MAILED (OR GIVEN) TO STUDENTS AFTER the 2nd PAYMENT and no later than February 1st. Once we receive them from the instructor, an email will be sent out with information on delivery of kits.

**Alphabet of Stitches Redux. \$241, including lunch (2-day class)
Tue Feb 13 & Wed Feb 14, 2024**



DESCRIPTION: This fun sampler is like an appetizer plate – it gives the stitcher a small ‘taste’ of each stitch without being overwhelming. As a bonus, while learning these stitches, the students will also learn some of the history of samplers and the stitches used. This Alphabet of Stitches starts with A – Assisi through Z – Zigzag Chain with many stitches in between!

GROUND & THREADS: The ground fabric is 32-count Belfast linen with 8 shades of 12-wt Sulky cotton petites in vibrant colors.

STUDENTS PROVIDE: Usual stitching supplies, including scissors, extra magnification and lighting (optional, but must be battery operated, i.e., no extension cords). A stitching frame or scroll rods are strongly recommended for this sampler.

PRE-WORK REQUIRED. KIT WILL BE MAILED (OR GIVEN) TO STUDENTS AFTER the 2nd PAYMENT and no later than February 1st. Once we receive them from the instructor, an email will be sent out with information on delivery of kits

Cancellation Policy and Payment Plan

1. CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations are made at the discretion of the Workshop Chair or her designee. If there is a waitlist for the class, your payment will be refunded upon receipt of a new student's paid enrollment. Because the class is based on per student costs, if you cancel and there is no wait list, your payment is forfeited. **Once the kit(s) are mailed to you for pre-work, cancellations will not be accepted.**
2. The class price covers kit fee, teaching costs, and facility usage fee. A light lunch and snacks will be provided. If you have special food requirements, please let Stephanie know in advance!
3. A Payment Plan is available. IRC can only accept checks.
See the schedule for the class(es) you are planning to take. If you select both classes, payment schedules for both classes must be met, i.e., if you are an EGA member registering for both classes, a deposit of \$150 is expected by 18 December 2023; if you are a Non-EGA member registering for both classes, a deposit of \$175 is expected by 18 December 2023.
